Their vision of accessibility in the arts is unprecedented, simultaneously creating rewarding audience experiences. In a brilliantly staged story, *Farfalle* loosely follows the life cycle of a butterfly--from egg to caterpillar, cocoon to butterfly--with beautiful botanical images and captivating rainforest sounds emerging from every direction.
