WU FEI *HELLO GOLD MOUNTAIN* | February 9, 2023 School Show at Zoellner & Workshop Opportunities

Meditation — Gravity for the mind and heart. In this 45-60 minute workshop, participants will exit their daily stress and be surrounded by the deep resonance of the guzheng. The sound of plucked strings is like raindrops falling in a lake. Wu Fei will direct the participants to time travel with her instrument to achieve deep breathing throughout the session.

Improvisation workshop — my favorite things! Students will bring one of their favorite "things" from home or the classroom (such as stuffy, a toy, books, stickers, their own drawings, a leaf, a flower, etc.). Wu Fei will conduct a music game collaborating with the students and their favorite things. Students will gain an understanding that improvisation is everywhere in one's life. (with school students who may not have music training)



Lectures/Q& A for school students Wu Fei will talk about the history of Hello Gold Mountain from how she discovered this history to turn the inspiration to a large music work. She will play a section from the composition, and share some precious photos from the Jewish people in Shanghai donated by her friend in San Francisco. Q & A at the end with the students.
