SOUNDPAINTING

(Please sing along!)

POP UP employs a compositional technique called Soundpainting. Soundpainting is the universal sign language for live composition. The language is made up of over 1500 signs and allows a conductor/ composer to sculpt a performance in real-time with improvising actors, musicians, dancers, and visual artists. N.Y. composer Walter Thompson created the technique in the late 1970s for jazz musicians. It has evolved into a multidisciplinary language that is practiced in 35 countries across the world. Strike Anywhere is the preeminent theater ensemble in the United States practicing Soundpainting.
