

Covid-19 Reopening Guidelines

Zoellner Arts Center is committed to following the Lehigh University guidelines on COVID-19 safety. **This** document details additional policies and procedures in place at Zoellner to maintain the health and safety of our students, faculty, staff and patrons. I. MAINTAINING A HEALTHY WORK ENVIRONMENT

A. GENERAL PRACTICES AND OFFICE WORK

- Provide fully stocked handwashing stations for staff in Baker Hall and Diamond Theater.
- All staff, crew & volunteers are trained in use and safe removal of PPE
- Avoid handshaking
- Infection Mitigation Coordinator appointed
- Provide written and posted protocols of refusal policies for not adhering to the Lehigh guidelines on Covid-19.

B. FRONT OF HOUSE

- Close every other ticket window
- Encourage cash-free payment for patrons to swipe cards; machine is disinfected preand post- transaction
- Contactless ticket options include mobile and print at home ticket delivery
 - Provide option for guests to retrieve tickets directly from the printer
- Encourage guests to pick up tickets in advance of performance date

C. TECHNICAL SERVICES

BACKSTAGE, ONSTAGE, LOADING & STORAGE AREAS

- Truck drivers with tours will follow the information from the fronting document
- Designate separate entrances for special deliveries and receiving
- Follow current guidelines about surface contamination
- Work in consistent teams to limit exposure
- Disinfect touch points within entryway
- Reduce overhead work whenever possible or stagger timing of activities to reduce risk. Rig all points in advance if possible.
- Reduce number of personnel allowed backstage, onstage, in control booths, dressing rooms & green room
- Disinfect all high touch theatrical equipment after each use
- Encourage alternatives to the climbing ladders
- Encourage touring companies to not use enclosed booth spaces
- Eliminate buffet style catering; use individually packaged beverages, snacks, utensils, etc.
- Find an alternative location for breaks that have increased space
- Limit use of washing machines to show-only laundry
- Work with visiting companies on quick change set-ups to include curtain barriers between stations
- Follow industry-standard safety guidelines for musician setups

ARTIST TRANSPORTATION

- Reduce vehicle capacity to conform to safety guidelines
- Passengers required to wear face coverings while riding, and wash hands or use hand sanitizer after leaving the vehicle.
- Vehicles will be cleaned before & after each use

II. PUBLIC EVENTS

A. WHILE ON PREMISES

- Parking
 - Encourage cash-free payment and disinfect card readers regularly
- Concessions
 - Pre-packaged food and beverages
 - Establish line direction and alternate locations
 - Provide areas where masks can be removed temporarily to consume concessions
- Merchandise
 - Relocate merchandise location to Butz Lobby
 - Sell Music Department CDs through ticket office
- Restrooms
 - Staff to monitor restroom capacity when possible
- Ticket Office
 - Sanitize the counters between patrons and wear gloves when handling cash.
 - Establish will-call pickup times to reduce peak traffic
- Elevator use
 - Staff to monitor elevator capacity when possible
- Lobbies & Common Spaces
 - Minimize setups that encourage gatherings, such as meet and greets

B. ENTERING & EXITING THE THEATRES

- Doors will be split for entering & exiting Baker Hall
- Patrons using stairs will be instructed to maintain distance from seated patrons
- Relocate scanning locations away from doorway to increase distancing
- Contactless ticket scanning
- Implement safe-distance seating for all events
- Seat patrons by section and from front to back when possible
- Implement contact-free playbill/program distribution.
- Dismiss patrons by section
- Eliminate backstage access
- Eliminate playbill reuse

C. COMMUNICATION WITH PATRONS
